This week **Ride the Lightning** turns 40. Cliff had uploaded his genius on it, thus making it the most bass-packed Metallica album. Even though I didn't have time to (re)transcribe the entire album (we'll do it eventually anyways), two special tabs have been made for this occasion.

First is a renovated **The Call of Ktulu**. You had an early access to it a few weeks before (check our newsletter vault, link below) and pointed out one major mistake, which I promptly fixed in addition to some minor fresh-ear polishing. A new isolated track and commentary are available as well.

Second is **For Whom the Bell Tolls**, another bass classic off RTL. But there's a nuance: it's gone DEATH METAL. And so has the entire record thanks to Denis Pauna. This was my first ever arrangement in that style, but it turned out pretty good, and it still carries a strong Burton flavor. The project goes live on the album's birthday July 27th, but you can have the bass tabs right now, plus an early peek into my bass video (warning: bass face goes hard there).
